Learn About Your Electric Generation

If you do not exercise your right under Ohio law to choose a generation provider, the electric distribution utility is required to provide you "standard service", which means the electric distribution utility - Ohio Power Company -- is required to buy generation on your behalf. Ohio Power Company passes these charges through dollar-for-dollar and makes no money from them. For your rate schedule, the standard service rate (Price to Compare) is currently \$0.096/kWh. That means a generation provider must offer you a rate lower than \$0.096/kWh for you to save money. Contact Ohio Power Company to obtain an explanation of Price to Compare.
